About Us

Southside Road Surgery has a list size of around 5000 patients. We are located in the capital of the Scottish Highlands, which is renowned for its stunning scenery, and ease of access to outdoor activities. We have purpose built owned buildings offering a spacious and pleasant environment. The buildings have 12 downstairs consulting rooms, including a minor surgery/treatment room, a dedicated meeting room with separate computer stations, a large clinical training room, 2 waiting rooms (both downstairs) and reception and administrative open plan offices.
